



Alumni & Association trustee Role

This document is to be read in conjunction with the Trustee role description.

Role

The Alumni & Association trustee of St Paul's Steiner School is responsible for the oversight of development and promotion of strong alumni relations and a vibrant association.

Purpose

While all Trustees have ultimate responsibility for the organisation, the Alumni & Association trustee helps the other trustees view their roles considering the school's alumni current and future.

Key responsibilities

In addition to the responsibilities set out in the Trustee role description, the specific role of the Alumni and Association trustee is:

- To oversee long-range strategic development of a strong alumni and association.
- To help identify with ways of engaging current and future alumni.
- To have oversight of relationships with alumni and their families, social media and events.
- To bring knowledge of their experience at St Paul's to improve pupil experience.

Time commitment at the school:

Approximately 6 hours a month. In addition to attending the six board meetings a year, and the Annual General Meeting, the trustee will meet with their link in the school termly.

Desired Specifications:

- To have attended St Paul's Steiner School (ideally through Class VIII)
- An appreciation and enthusiasm for the benefits of a Steiner-Waldorf education, providing a true educational alternative in central London.
- Understanding of the importance of having a strong association and alumni community
