

WRAT Analysis 2021-2022

The school monitors children in reading, spelling and maths using Wide Range Achievement Test (WRAT) tests which run from Class 2 (Y3) to Class 8 (Y9) every in October and February.

Children's attainment is monitored twice a year using the Wide Range Achievement Tests (WRAT) from Class 2 up to Class 8.

As of February 2022

- **35%** of children are achieving **above average** (high, above, well above) scores in reading.
- **18%** of children are achieving **above average** in mathematics.

- 75% of children in the school are achieving average or above in reading
- 57% of children are achieving average or above in spelling
- 80% of children are achieving average or above in maths.
