- 1. Every member of the Association shall either sign a written consent to become a member or sign the register of member on becoming a member.
- 2. The Association is established for the purposes expressed in the Memorandum of Association
- 3. The Subscribers to the Memorandum of Association and such other persons as the Board of Trustees shall admit to membership in accordance with the provisions hereinafter contained shall be members of the Association. A person may only be a member of the Association if such person is also a member of St Pauls Steiner Building, the intention being that at all times the membership of the Association will be identical.
